STEP 5: REVIEW SECURITY GUIDELINES

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To ensure safety and security of staff and volunteers during the implementation of the early actions, review your existing security guidelines and decide whether an additional assessment or measures are necessary during the implementation.

Currently, anticipatory action is mainly implemented in non-conflict settings. However, the Red Cross Red Crescent movement is exploring how anticipatory action can be implemented during ongoing conflicts. This is a movement-wide initiative which includes National Societies, and IFRC and ICRC.
