Theory of Change

A comprehensive description and illustration of how and why a desired change is expected to happen in a particular context. It is focused in particular on mapping out what has been described as the “missing middle” between what a programme or change initiative does (its actions or interventions) and how these lead to desired goals being achieved.

In FbF, a Theory of Change is an essential tool to select those early actions that have the most potential to reduce the identified risks.
